

## EXODUS, PART 2

Old Testament Survey Series – Study # 6

### Key Themes of Exodus 19-40

1. After rescuing Israel from slavery, God initiates a \_\_\_\_\_ relationship with Israel for the sake of the \_\_\_\_\_. (Exodus 19:1-6)
  - A. God calls Israel to become a “kingdom of \_\_\_\_\_” who will mediate between God and all the nations:  
GOD ← \_\_\_\_\_ → NATIONS
  - B. This is a development of the promise to \_\_\_\_\_ in Genesis 12:1-3.
  - C. Israel’s \_\_\_\_\_ to the covenant is crucial to the plan of God’s presence and character becoming accessible to the nations.
2. God gives Israel the \_\_\_\_\_, which explains the terms of the covenant. (Exodus 20-23)
  - A. Torah = Instruction, \_\_\_\_\_
  - B. It begins with the Ten Commandments and is followed by other laws that affect every area of Israel’s \_\_\_\_\_ together.
  - C. Living by these laws will make Israel a nation of justice and generosity that reflects God’s own \_\_\_\_\_. (See Deuteronomy 4:5-8)
3. Israel \_\_\_\_\_ to the covenant, and God promises to live \_\_\_\_\_ his people in the tabernacle. (Exodus 24-31)

4. Israel \_\_\_\_\_ rebels and disobeys the covenant as they make and worship the golden calf. (Exodus 32-34)
  - A. The people forget God’s \_\_\_\_\_ and offer their allegiance to an idol.
  - B. God is angry and wants to abandon the covenant, but invites Moses to \_\_\_\_\_ for the people.
  - C. God brings \_\_\_\_\_, but also shows \_\_\_\_\_.  
God's reveals His character. (Exodus 34:6-7)
5. Moses oversees the construction and dedication of the \_\_\_\_\_, but is unable to enter it to meet with God who has manifested His presence there. (Exodus 35-40)
